Short Title: Participation in the Northwest Tribal Emergency Management Council
(NWTEMC)

WHEREAS, the Cowlitz Indian Tribe is Acknowledged as a Sovereign Indian Nation by the United States Governments, and

WHEREAS, the Cowlitz Indian Tribal Council is the governing body of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe as authorized by the Tribe's Constitution and By-laws, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe adopts regulations and approves policies and procedures whenever necessary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe realizes there is an advantage for all parties, by participating with, training and exercising with other Recognized Tribes in the state for the purpose of Emergency Management, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe does also recognize that planning, exercising, individual and collective preparedness and maintaining a Point of Contact (POC) is of the utmost importance for continued survival of the Tribe and it's members and employees, and

WHEREAS, the participation of the Cowlitz Tribe with the other member Tribes of the NWTEMC, will facilitate the above,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe, authorizes our Tribe to initiate and sustain participation in the NWTEMC, at no cost to the Tribe, other than maintaining a POC.
