RESOLUTION NO. OF THE MAKAH TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Makah Tribal Council is the governing body of the Makah Indian Tribe of the Makah Reservation, Washington by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Makah Indian Tribe as approved on May 16, 1936 by the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Makah Tribal Council has the authority to initiate participation in established programs for the benefit and well-being of the Tribe and its employees, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council realizes there is an advantage for all parties, by participating with, training and exercising with other Recognized Indian Tribes in the State for the purpose of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council does also recognize that planning, exercising, individual and collective preparedness and maintaining a Point of Contact (POC) is one of the utmost importance for continued survival of the Tribes and its Members and employees, and

WHEREAS, the Participation of the Makah Tribe with the other member Tribes of the Northwest Tribal Emergency Management Council (NWTEMC) will facilitate the above;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, the Makah Tribal Council hereby authorizes our designated Tribal Representative Vince Cooke, Environmental Division Manager (lead) and Carol Claplanhoo (alt.) to initiate and sustain participation in the NWTEMC, at no cost to the Tribe, other than maintaining a POC.
