TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 07-339

To participate in the ~~Northwest Tribal Emergency~~ Management Council
(NWTEC)

WHEREAS, the Muckleshoot Indian Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body for the Muckleshoot Indian Reservation by authority of and is herein acting solely pursuant to its constitution and bylaws approved May 13, 1936 by the Secretary of the Interior, and as amended June 28, 1977 and not pursuant to its Indian Reorganization Act Corporate Charter ratified October 31, 1936; and

WHEREAS, Article VI.1.g. of the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws empowers the Tribal Council to appropriate and expend Tribal funds; and

WHEREAS, the Muckleshoot Indian Tribal Council has the authority to initiate participation in established programs for the benefit and well-being of the Tribe and its employees, and

WHEREAS, the Muckleshoot Indian Tribal Council realizes that there is an advantage for all parties, by participating with , training and exercising with other Recognized Indian Tribes in the State for the purpose of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the Muckleshoot Indian Tribal Council does recognize that planning, exercising, individual and collective preparedness and maintaining a Point of Contact (POC) is of the utmost importance for continued success of Emergency Preparedness, and

WHEREAS, the participation of the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe with other member Tribes of the NWTEMC will facilitate the above, this participation should be initiated by Tribal Council Resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe that our designated Tribal Operations Manager be authorized to direct the Tribes Emergency preparedness Manager to initiate and sustain participation in the NWTEMC, at no cost to the Tribe, other than maintaining a POC.

CERTIFICATION
