**WHEREAS,** The Samish Indian Nation was Federally re-acknowledged by the Assistant Secretary of the Department of the Interior of the United States of America on April 6, 1996; and

**WHEREAS,** The Samish Tribal Council is empowered to act on behalf of the Samish Indian Nation pursuant to Article VI, Section 2, of the Samish Tribal Constitution, approved November 14, 2003, by Resolution of the Samish Tribal Council and adopted and ratified by Vote of the Samish General Council on March 2, 2004; and

**WHEREAS,** The health, safety, welfare and education of the Indian people of the Samish Indian Nation is the responsibility of the Samish Indian Nation Tribal Council; and

**WHEREAS,** The Samish Tribal Council is aware that the Samish Indian Nation is eligible to belong to the Northwest Tribal Emergency Management Council that a delegate and alternate need to be appointed to represent the Tribe.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Council of the Samish Indian Nation hereby identifies the following delegate and alternate to the (NWTEMC) Northwest Tribal Emergency Management Council.
