**SILETZ TRIBAL COUNCIL
Resolution**

WHEREAS, the Siletz Tribal Council is empowered to exercise the legislative and executive authority of the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians of Oregon pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 of the Siletz Constitution approved June 13, 1979, by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians (CTSI) has the authority to initiate participation in established programs for the benefit and well-being of the Tribe, its members, and its employees; and

WHEREAS, the CTSI realizes that there is an advantage for all tribes to work together, as well as train and exercise, with other Indian tribes for the purpose of Emergency Management and Homeland Security; and

WHEREAS, the CTSI does recognize that planning, exercising, individual and collective preparedness and maintaining a Point-of-Contact is of the utmost importance for the continued success of Emergency Preparedness; and

WHEREAS, the participation of CTSI with other member tribes of the NW Tribal Emergency Management Council will facilitate the above; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Siletz Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribe's participation in the NW Tribal Emergency Management Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED, the Siletz Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal General Manager to appoint the appropriate staff representative.
